A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF THE BROWARD METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION'S 2045 METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN DRAFT COST FEASIBLE PLAN AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization approved the draft Cost Feasible Plan on May 9, 2019; and

WHEREAS, certain transportation projects have been identified and are currently ranked projects in the approved draft 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan Cost Feasible Plan, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein; and

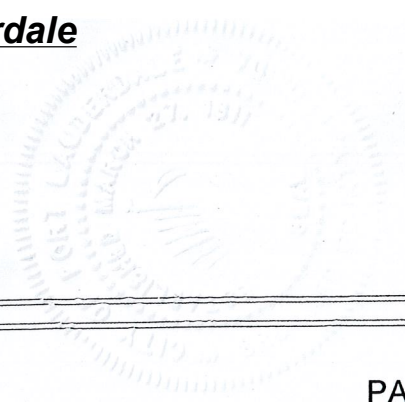

**SECTION 2.** The office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by City officials.


