Greg, please be advised we have completed construction of the supplemental safety measures required for the implementation of the quiet zone in Broward County.

We delivered the "No Train Horn" placards to Broward County, and it is our understanding that Broward County is coordinating with FDOT on the installation of roadway signage advising motorists of the quiet zone.

Quiet zones are quality of life improvements that can only be applied for by the cities or counties with jurisdiction over the adjacent roadway. As you know, Brightline has engaged in an aggressive safety outreach campaign over the past few years. Now is the time for cities and the county to start educating their residents and stakeholders on what the quiet zone will mean when implemented. We reemphasize our commitment to being your partner and educating the communities about rail safety.

Please keep us updated on the filing of the Notice of Establishment and expected date of the implementation of the quiet zone. We will coordinate with the Florida East Coast Railway. Thank you.
