City of Fort Lauderdale Complete Streets



- Participated in TAC since inception
- Applied for and received technical assistance
(Tara Salmieri)
 - Expect results in September 2012

City of Fort Lauderdale Complete Streets



- June 5, 2012 - City Commission was briefed on Complete Streets and gave an initial endorsement
- August 21, 2012 – Smart Growth to present at City Commission Conference Meeting – 12 Principles
- September 4, 2012 – City Commission to consider Smart Growth Resolution

City of Fort Lauderdale Complete Streets



- MPO to adopt model Complete Streets on July 12, 2012
- This fall, City staff will begin drafting Complete Streets code recommendations tailored for the specific requirements of the City (dense urban downtown, multiple Complete Street models, etc.)
 - Recommendations provided through MPO model
 - Smart Growth technical assistance
- Planned adoption of code changes in Spring 2013
