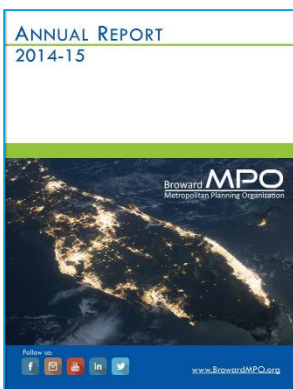

#### 2014-2015 Annual Report

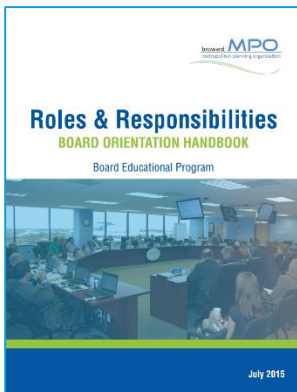

The *Board Orientation Handbook: Roles and Responsibilities* was published in July 2015 providing new Board members essential, concise information on fulfilling their MPO duties in advancing regional transportation priorities. This 11-page document simplifies the complex roles of Board members by introducing them to what the MPO does, their responsibilities as Board members, and other agencies and planning partners that provide support and guidance. In addition, the *Handbook* provides a brief overview of the core products of the MPO, such as the Long-Range Plan (LRTP) and Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and their role in their development.
