


Corridor Project: Las Olas Protected Bike Lanes

- In 2014, the City partnered with FDOT to time a Lane Elimination with scheduled resurfacing
- Two Lanes (East and West) were removed and a center landscape median was added


Goals:


- Improve Pedestrian, Bike and Automotive Safety

This was accomplished by:


- Adding new and Enhance Existing Crosswalks











Promotes complete streets design with private developers.


> Seeks opportunities for funding for complete streets projects.


