




Narrative: (300-word limit)

Broward County, Florida, is part of the 14th most dangerous region in the country as identified in the 2022 Dangerous By Design report. Though local governments have adopted Vision Zero safety performance measures, meaningful change is not occurring fast enough. Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (BMPO), lead applicant, with Broward County government, joint applicant, are requesting a \$5 million Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant award to develop a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan (AP). The County will provide a \$1.25 million local match. An inclusive analysis of facilities, crash data, policies, and equity will be conducted. This process will provide low cost, high impact approaches such as region-wide safe speeds strategies, Complete Streets and Vision Zero policies, and deployment strategies for innovative technologies. Infrastructure improvements such as separated facilities, low-stress multimodal safety projects, school zone and intersection safety improvements will be identified. The principles of the Safe Systems Approach and various published design guidance (ex. NACTO) will inform recommendations. Innovative technology (ex. near-miss identification, Al traffic signal and detection, Smart City) strategies and projects will be reflected in the AP. Projects will be identified and prioritized as short and long-term projects.

BMPO will utilize its successful data-driven, equity-based public outreach strategies to involve all communities. High-tech strategies will employ social media and on-line surveys, while high-touch strategies will focus on leveraging existing relationships with partners who have well-established programs in traditionally underrepresented communities. A diverse oversight board will be established to guide the development of an equitable and well-informed AP. It will include representatives from the health industry, law enforcement, private sector, elected officials, and community champions.

Safety will be evaluated from a holistic perspective throughout the County. The SS4A grant will provide the opportunity to reduce severe injuries and traffic fatalities to zero.




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




Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization - Broward County Location Map and Major Roadway Network
