| 1 | 350 | Lauderdale Lakes | NW 41st Street Multi-Use Path | Installation of a multi-use path on either side of NW 41st St from SR-7 and NW 31st Ave in addition to two new community shuttle stops. | \$ 1,766,591.59 |
| 2 | 335 | Hollywood | Sidewalk Infill Project | Construct new sidewalk to fill in missing segments in the area between I-95 to the west, Dixie Hwy to the east, Pembroke Rd to the south and Johnson St to the north. | \$ 4,280,765.01 |
| 3 | 320 | Fort Lauderdale | NE 15th Avenue Mobility Project | Enhanced bike lanes, new and enhanced crosswalks, new and extended landscaped medians, and raised intersections at various points along NE 15th Ave from NE 11th St to the Middle River. | \$ 4,190,442.70 |
| 4 | 300 | Oakland Park | NE 15th Avenue and Side Streets | Construct sidewalks along NE 15th Ave from E Oakland Park Blvd to NE 38th St and on the cross streets from NE 32nd St to NE 37 St extending from NE 13th Ave to NE 16th Ave. | \$ 1,568,825.83 |
| 5 | 245 | Lauderhill | NW 50th Street Multi-Use Path | Construct a shared use path on the south side of NW 50th St from N University Dr to N Pine Island Rd as well as a roundabout at NW 50th St and NW 82nd Ave. | \$ 1,461,011.24 |
| 6 | 210 | Sunrise | NW 94 Ave/NW 42 St/NW 50 St Bike Lanes | Provide dedicated bicycle lanes on NW 94th Ave, NW 42nd St and NW 50th St. Install a roundabout at NW 94th Ave and NW 42nd St. | \$ 4,971,231.65 |
| 7 | 225 | Deerfield Beach | NE Eller Street Improvements | Provide a shared use path, pedestrian lighting, enhanced crosswalks, traffic calming elements and other improvements on NE Eller St from NE 9th Ave to Deerfield Ave. | \$ 5,472,161.46 |
| 8 | 205 | Wilton Manors | NE 21st Court Improvements | Provide a sidewalk connection on the north side of NE 21st Ct from NE 1st Ave to NE 5th Ave. Raised intersection at NE 5th Ave. | \$ 695,212.45 |
| 9 | 200 | Miramar | Bass Creek Road Mobility Improvements | Construct a roundabout at Bass Creek Rd and Lakeside Dr. Construct an 8-foot-wide sidewalk on the south side of Bass Creek Rd between Lakeside Dr and Dykes Rd. | \$ 4,715,065.76 |
| 9 | 200 | Coral Springs | NW 40 Street Mobility Improvements | Replace asphalt sidewalks with a concrete multi-use path, provide traffic calming elements, new curb and gutter on NW 40th St from N University Dr to Riverside Dr. | \$ 1,304,776.32 |
| 11 | 130 | Weston | Bonaventure Area Bicycle Facilities | Addition of bicycle facilities on Blatt Blvd, Racquet Club Rd, Lakeview Dr, E. Mall Rd, and W. Mall Rd. At segments where existing conditions don't allow 5' bicycle lanes, sharrows are proposed. | \$ 5,093,624.01 |
| 12 | 290 | Lauderdale Lakes | Greenway Trail on C-13 Canal | Construct a new multi-use greenway trail on the south side of South Florida Water management District C-13 Canal between SR-7 and NW 32 Way. | \$ 1,604,652.27 |
| 13 | 285 | Fort Lauderdale | NE 26th Street Mobility Project | Construct a sidewalk on the north side of NE 26th St from US-1 to Bayview Dr. Also add bike lanes, raised intersections, tighten turning radii and add a roundabout at Bayview Dr. | \$ 4,988,204.59 |
| 14 | 265 | Hollywood | Tyler Street Traffic Flow Modification | Convert Tyler St from a one-way to a two-way road from N 21st Ave to N Yound Cir. Landscape bulb outs, crosswalks, traffic signalization, and roadway and sidewalk improvements. | \$ 6,257,925.94 |
| 15 | 235 | Sunrise | Josh Lee Boulevard Complete Street | Convert Josh Lee Blvd from a four-lane road to a two-lane road, replace existing sidewalk on the north side of the road with a multi-use path. | \$ 4,149,442.62 |
