 - The team works to develop policy, review projects, and work with partners throughout the County to advance the Complete Streets/ Safe Streets concept

County Projects

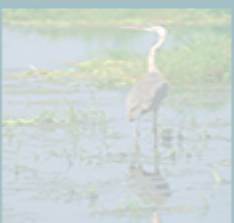
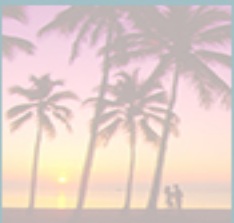
- The County has already begun to implement Complete Street and Safe Street initiatives:
