### Highlights

#### TRAC & RIDES Program



TRAC (Transportation and Civil Engineering) is a hands-on, educational outreach program of the American Association of State Highway Transportation Officials (AASHTO). The TRAC program is designed for integration into the teaching of science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM). State Departments of Transportation provide the program free of charge to middle and high schools in their State. The Broward MPO has worked with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) to bring this program to Florida. Following the success of the training held at the MPO in February 2015 a two day workshop for physics teachers is scheduled for June 28 & 29. The MPO hopes to make this an annual training event and would like to be

able to purchase materials for teachers to use in the classroom after their training.

This is an important initiative for the MPO. Across the country, it is becoming increasingly difficult to attract young men and women, especially young people of diverse ethnic backgrounds, to the world of transportation planning and engineering. Many agencies and organizations refer to it as the "<u>Silver Tsunami</u>"; this is an opportunity for the MPO to help.

#### Partnerships & Internships



Following our meeting with Superintendent Runcie and Ms. Good on December 14, 2015, staff from the MPO and Career, Technical, Adult and Community Education (CTACE) met to discuss possible opportunities to partner. One of the suggestions from CTACE was to explore partnership and internship opportunities. Brian King and Enid Valdez made presentations to the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC), Citizens' Advisory Committee (CAC) and MPO Board in February and March. At least five (5) people have shown interest in providing internship opportunities that Brian King

(CTACE) is following up on. This includes MPO Board members Commissioner Dale Holness, County Commission and Commissioner Yvette Colbourne, City of Miramar. Broward County Public Schools are striving to make the school curriculum more relevant to the work environment; this is an opportunity for the MPO to help.

#### Planning Exercise/Field Visit - Cypress Creek Mobility Hub



In an effort to provide education opportunities for school age children, MPO staff, with the help of CTACE, met with the principal and teachers of Deerfield High School. The intention is to hold a one day field visit/planning exercise at the MPO with Deerfield High School students. The field visit is scheduled for May (exact date to be determined). This is a pilot project with the intention of using this project with numerous other schools in the future.

Brian King and his colleagues are striving to make the school curriculum more relevant to the work environment; this is an
