Highlights

Mobility Program / Complete Streets Initiative



Through the Broward MPO's Mobility Program, over \$100 million in bicycle and pedestrain improvements (including sidewalks, multi-use paths, and bicycle lanes) have been programmed over the next four years (2015-2019). The first phase of projects, located throughout the Broward region, reflect a continuing partnership between the Broward MPO, the Florida Departement of Transportation (FDOT), Broward County Government and municipalities. On February 3, 2015, a ground breaking event took place within the City of Hollywood with more than 60 community leaders, residents, and members of the media in attendance. The Mobility Program will continue to fund future multimodal projects that complete the regional network vision.
